

"When I was"

The parable of the sheep and the goats

From Matthew twenty five:

Key words

King: Fanfare.

Sheep: Bah.

Goats: Naah.

Hungry: Ohh, rub tummy.

Thirsty: stick out Tongue and pant.

Stranger: Hello, who are you?

Naked: Brrrr.

Sick: pretend to Vomit.

Prison: Let me out, let me out!

At the end of time, Jesus the King (fanfare) will come to the earth. All the people of the earth will gather before the King (fanfare) and he will divide them up, putting one group on his right and the others on his left. Just like a shepherd divides the Sheep (baah) from the Goats (naah). He will put the Sheep (baah) on his right and the Goats (naah) on his left.

Then Jesus the King (fanfare) will say to the sheep (baah) on his right: "You are blessed by God; come and take your place in my Kingdom. And the Sheep (baah) on his right will look at the King (fanfare) and say: "But when Lord, when? When did we do all these things for you? And the King (fanfare) will say: "You know whatever you did for even the lowliest of people you did for me."

Then the King (fanfare) will say to the Goats (naah) on his left: "Go away from me for there is no place for you here. For when I was hungry (rub tummy) you left me to starve. When I was thirsty (pant) you didn't even give me a glass of water. When I was a stranger (hello, who are you) you left me out in the cold. When I was naked (Brrrrr) you left me to shiver. When I was sick (vomit) you didn't look after me. When I was in prison (let me out) you just left me there to rot on my own."

"But, but , but," the Goats (Naah) on the Kings (fanfare) left will say. When did we not do all these things for you? We can't remember!

"Well," The King (fanfare) will say, "whatever you didn't do for even the lowliest person you didn't do for me . For I am the Hungry (rub tummy), the thirsty (pant), the stranger (hello, who are you?), the Naked (brrrrr), the sick (vomit), and the prisoner (let me out!) and you passed me by".

Then the King (fanfare) will say to the Goats (naah): “leave me, for I have no place for you”, and to the Sheep (baah): “come with me to share in my glory for all eternity”.
