- 2: an oily rag and
- 3: a lot of pond weed
- 1: to chew on just before bedtime. However, the same can be achieved by
- 2: blowing it up with a high pressure air line and
- 3: Leaving it in a dry place at the back of the shed for about three weeks.
- 1: Bath time can be fun for Baby and for you, however if you are rushed for time you could
- 2: put it through the car wash, or

3: give it a thick coat of clear varnish to keep it clear and waterproof for the whole year.
