Characters

David.

Announcer.

Scene: The Royal throne room. There are two thrones toward the back of the stage.

(David and Mr Samuel walk onto the stage)

David: And I thought you were just some sort of mad weirdo at the time.

Mr Sam: Well that's all in the past. The important thing is that now you are going to

(Mrs Jessie comes blustering in)

Mrs Jess: Well I never, my little David, my little boy, my little baby, (she tickles him

under the chin) my little chubby chops going to be King, and all those people outside cheering for you. You,re such a hero David, and just think, I never thought you'd come to anything. As I told your father many times: He's a loser that one you know. He'll get nowhere. He'll just spend all his time

with that blessed sheep.

(Larry enters)

David: Ah Larry, Mum was just talking about you.

Mrs Jess: Oh yes Larry. How nice to meet you again. Any friend of David's is a great

friend of mine. As I always said .....

Mr Sam: The time has come! We are ready to crown you the King!

David: Oh, there's one thing I forgot to say. I'll only be King if Larry here is crowned

as deputy King at the same time. Is that all right?

Mr Sam: Ah hem .... well its a bit unusual, but in the circumstances I think it will be all

right.

(Larry bleats nervously)

Mr Sam: But are you sure he's happy about it, he looks a little sheepish to me!

Announcer: And now let the ceremony begin. The crowning of King David and King

Larry.

(Coronation Music as David and Larry move to sit on the Thrones, Music fades)

Mr Sam: (Placing a crown on each head) I crown you King David

Announcer: Long live the King! Long live the King!

(Others encourage the audience to join in)

Mr Sam: And I crown you King Larry.

Announcer: Long live the King! Long live the King!

(others encourage the Audience to join in)

Announcer: So let the party begin

Sing: When the Spirit of the Lord is within my heart I will sing as David Sang etc And other suitable celebratory songs.
